









- Increase sharpness by using steady camera and good light.
- Center the subject and keep consistent headroom.
- Avoid overexposed highlights and deep shadows.
- Refine silhouette line with stronger posture and clearer garment shape.
- Strengthen body line and silhouette so the pose reads more fashion-forward.

Next step: Improve posture and line so silhouettes read stronger in fashion framing.

- Keep lighting soft and even across the face.
- Maintain simple styling and clean backgrounds.
- Keep expression natural and camera-aware.


Reshoot Checklist

- Use soft, even light to avoid harsh shadows or blown highlights

- Frame the subject centrally and keep the full silhouette visible
- Use a steady surface or tripod to reduce blur
- Lengthen posture and engage core to create cleaner fashion lines
- Wear simple, fitted clothing to keep the silhouette clear

How to improve: Use soft front-side light and keep exposure consistent across frames.

Cohesion

What it means: Measures how consistent your set feels in light, background, and color.

How to improve: Keep location, white balance, and setup similar when shooting the sequence.

Fashion Fit

What it means: Measures silhouette strength, posture quality, and framing of body lines.

How to improve: Lengthen posture, keep line clean, and avoid cramped composition.

Palette

What it means: Measures color harmony and tone consistency across photos.

How to improve: Use coordinated wardrobe tones and stable color temperature.
