



What to Keep

- Keep lighting soft and even across the face.
- Maintain simple styling and clean backgrounds.

Reshoot Checklist

- Use soft, even light to avoid harsh shadows or blown highlights
- Keep consistent headroom and avoid cutting off hands or feet
- Keep makeup minimal and even to avoid shine on the T-zone
- Use a simple wall or neutral backdrop to keep focus on the subject
- Wear simple, fitted clothing to keep the silhouette clear
